



WEDDINGS, BAPTISMS AND FUNERALS

The Unitarian and Free Christian approach to baptisms, weddings and funerals is unique, in that there is no pre-existing order of service. The ceremony is compiled with the consultation of the chief participants and the minister in order to ensure that it reflects the beliefs, values and priorities of those involved. For persons who are considering marking an event of life's transitions at the chapel, it is important first to speak with the minister, who will be able to answer any questions.

Weddings

Wedding services can take place on any day of the week, between the hours of 8am and 6pm. The fees are as follows:

Funerals

Funeral services and memorial services are conducted on days of the week and at times that are agreed between the minister and the chief mourners.
